The Finance Director reviewed the bi-weekly financial report for the periods ending February 15, 2024, February 29, 2024, and March 14, 2024. The Finance Director informed the Commissioners the MTF funds to date increased for the YTD is 6.57% (Increase \$239,284). The Finance Director informed the Commissioners that they had received January's deposit from the Oxcart Permits Systems in the amount of \$23,625.00 and February's deposit in the amount of \$21,015.00. The Finance Director explained that the only outstanding invoice on the AR report is the Mid-Michigan Community Pathway's invoice. She explained that the Mid-Michigan Community Pathway had paid a small payment on the outstanding invoice. The Finance Director informed the Commissioners that she had been busy working on contracts and estimates. The Finance Director informed the Finance Directors who use Precision software. At this meeting every module was discussed in detail to get a list of things that we would like to see changed or approved. Precision Computer Solutions is planning on bringing back the free user training sessions that they use to do. However, they now will be held via Zoom. The Finance Director informed the Commissioners that the next month or two that ICRC will be live on the RMS payroll.

The ICRC Engineer has had communication with Wise Township on what the proper process for abandonment of a road is. The Manager updated the Boad that the East Walton Road Bridge will now need to have a Native Muscle Survey done on it before work can be done on the Bridge. This survey will cost the Road Commission from \$5,000 to \$18,200 depending on what they find. The Manager informed the Board that he was asked to be the Vice President for MCRCSIP (Michigan County Road Commission Self Insurance Pool).
